

# My House

A **house** is a place where we live with our family. It gives us shelter and keeps us safe from rain, sun, cold, and storms. Every family's house is special and can look very different from others.

## Parts of a House

A house has many parts that help us live comfortably. Some important parts are:

- **Rooms:** These are the places inside the house where we do different activities. We have bedrooms to sleep, kitchens to cook food, living rooms to sit and talk, and bathrooms for washing.
- **Doors and Windows:** Doors let us enter and leave the house. Windows allow fresh air and sunshine to come inside.
- **Roof:** The roof is the top part of the house that protects us from rain, sun, and anything falling from above.
- **Walls:** Walls hold the house together and keep the air inside cool or warm.

## Materials Used to Build a House

Houses can be made from different materials depending on where we live. Some common materials used are:

- Bricks – red or white small blocks that are joined with cement.
- Wood – used for doors, windows, and sometimes walls.
- Stone – strong pieces used in walls.
- Clay or Mud – used in villages to make houses.
